

## **Pool Video Rules**

It is imperative that we protect the privacy of you, our clients, and your children, the Infant Swimming Resource (ISR) technique, and what we uniquely do as we shape vital self-rescue skills in our students. Below you will find a list of pool video guidelines. Thank you for your cooperation with these protocols.

- 1. Filming of ISR lessons is only allowed on Friday.
- 2. If you are interested in filming your child during a lesson, please let your Instructor know the day before your lesson.
- 3. Your Instructor will provide you with a video release form. This form must be signed and returned to your Instructor prior to filming.
- 4. All video taken during your ISR lesson must be given approval by your Instructor prior to being published on any Web sites including, but not limited to: Facebook, YouTube, Blogs, Personal Websites, Company Websites and MySpace.
- 5. If your Instructor sees you filming without permission, the Instructor may stop the lesson completely until the camera is shut off and authorization protocol is followed. Once written and verbal permission is given by the Instructor, skills may be video taped.
